- I, Leonard Gendron, declare and state as follows upon personal knowledge:
- 1. I am a resident of New Hampshire. I often try to preach the gospel on streets of Boston using a compact disc (CD) player with recorded music and I sing to its accompaniment.
- 2. On Saturday, June 16, 2005, I tried to do my routine presentation at Boston Common, Boston, a public space.
- 3. A mounted park ranger told me I could not preach without a license. I questioned him about it because I was aware of Stephen Baird's efforts in behalf of free expression in public places. The ranger then said I could not use an "amplifier" without a license.
- 4. It seemed clear to me he would arrest me if I did not stop. So I departed. I was confused and intimidated by his actions.
